NYK Line - Conditions for the acceptance of Dangerous Goods

Dear Valued Customers,

NYK Line wishes to send the below checklist of requirements that need to be adhered too when Exporting Dangerous Goods with NYK.

- 1: The shipment must conform to all International Maritime Organisation (IMO) (<http://www.imo.org/index.htm>) and Australia Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) (<http://www.amsa.gov.au>) requirements.
- 2: The shipment must conform to all relevant Federal and State DG legislation.
- 3: The Multimodal Dangerous Goods Form submitted for this consignment must be Completed correctly, as per AMSA guidelines, fully legible and contain all Required information for each line of cargo.
- 4: All sections of the Multimodal Dangerous Goods Form declaration Must be signed by the responsible party(ies).
- 5: The container / tanktainer must have the correct placards on all four sides of the container / tanktainer.
- 6: The PRA must be correctly completed and submitted to the Terminal.
- 7: The "Red Line" and/or "Green Line" constraints must be fully adhered to.
- 8: Documents and DG entry to relevant authority data systems are submitted within the required timeframes expected by those authorities.
- 9: **Dangerous Goods must not be packed into NYK Line containers without first receiving confirmation of acceptance from NYK Line.**
- 10: **Effective 1st October, 2009, Dangerous Goods must not be delivered into Brisbane Terminals without first receiving confirmation from NYK Line that the DG Entry has been lodged with Port of Brisbane 24 hours prior to delivery.**

Additionally, you are required to submit a preliminary Dangerous Goods Declaration to our office by no later than 4 working days (excludes weekends and public holidays) prior to the intended exporting vessel cargo receipt cut-off. This period is required to enable NYK Line to obtain approval from the respective vessel operators and transiting ports, to carry your cargo.

You are held responsible / liable for all fines/penalties/infringements/delays to vessels caused by you and/or your agents failing to comply with International, National, State regulations in force at the time of shipment. By placing a booking with NYK Line, you are accepting the "acceptance conditions" stated above and that the shipment will be subject to the terms and conditions of NYK Line Bill of Lading.
