10th November, 2010**CUSTOMER NOTICE****EU CUSTOMS ADVANCED MANIFEST RULE****(EUROPE 24-HOUR RULE)**

Dear Valued Customer,

NYK Line would like to advise that from 1st January, 2011, the Europe 24-Hour Rule will commence. This will mean any cargo arriving/transshipping in Europe on or after this date is required to be submitted prior. NYK will be starting below process from Vessel Voyage – **ANL Warringa 047N (11th November 2010)**

For all shipments that are discharging or transshipping through European Ports, Shipping Instructions must be sent to the local documentation team 24 HOURS PRIOR TO VESSEL ARRIVAL at each Australian Port of Load. If Shipping Instructions have not been received within this time frame any cargo booked with us may not be loaded.

We would like to remind you of the information you must include in your shipping instructions in order for us to submit the ENS:

- Full name and address (**including postal code**) of shipper and consignee on the B/L.
- Full name and address (**including postal code**) of the 1st notify party on the B/L, where the consignee is shown: To Order.
- Container number.
- Detailed Description of Goods.
- Four digits of the HS code.
- Number of packages.
- Package type description.
- Cargo gross weight.
- Seal number.
- UN dangerous goods code where applicable.
- Method of payment for transport charges in case of prepaid eg. "cash payment", "cheque payment", "electronic credit transfer", etc. (when available)

The Entry Summary Declaration (ENS) will be submitted to the first European port call of the vessel, however the ENS is required to cover all cargo on the vessel even if it remains on the vessel for subsequent ports outside of the European Union.
